Enrollment and Revenue Projection 2010-11 Student Fee Rate and Revenue Estimates





This report provides estimates for 2010-11 student fee rates and revenue. Student Health and IRA Fees were adjusted by the 2.3% annual HEPI percentage, then rounded to whole dollars. The MBA fee was adjusted by 10%.

The revenue is based on student enrollments of 6,850 total resident and non-resident FTES, down 4.2% from last year's 7,150 FTES budget. This equates to a 7,299 headcount forecast for 2010-11. Also, "Over 60" waivers were removed from the forecast, which for some fees were the majority of the waivers. These figures have not yet been approved and are only for planning.
